

Local Access Interactive Map

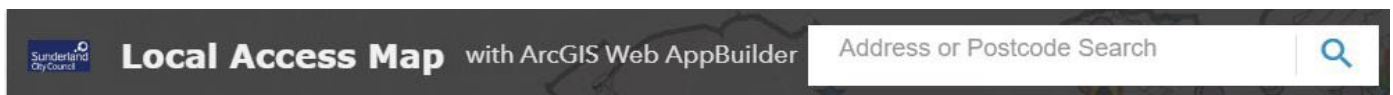
– user guide

The purpose of the Map is to allow the user to see what facilities are in their area.

To use the map:

Navigate to location

The search tool enables you to search for any address or postcode on the map.



Example

Let's say, a user of the interactive map wanted to see what facilities are in the vicinity of their home address. Type in your home address to the search bar, and the map will show the facilities in your area.




You can use the plus and minus symbols to zoom in and out of the map. The cursor can be used to drag the map to the required location.



The home icon can be used to return to the full extent of the map.

Locations

At the bottom left of the box is a 'Zoom to' link, and at the bottom right are three dots indicating more options.

Use the cursor to click on a particular site or location of interest. Once you have clicked on a site, a display box will open showing details of the location.

Where more than more than one location affects the site, the box displays at the top the number of layers which have been identified. The arrow at the top of the box can be used to scroll between these.

Please note however the display box only shows those layers that are turned on. If any layers have been unticked in the layer list, these will not be shown.

Legend



Use the following icon to show the legend of the interactive map.



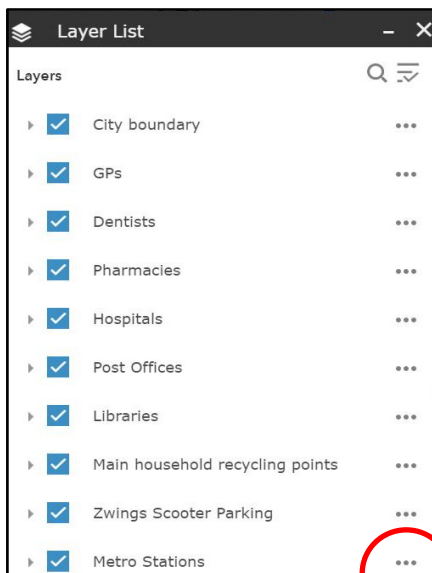
The legend lists all the layers that are displayed on the interactive map, and their individual notations.

Use the scrollbar, situated at the right-hand side of the legend, to reveal the full extent of the map's legend.

Layers



Use the following icon to show the layers of the interactive map.



Layers can be turned on and off in the map to select the points of interest you wish to see, by ticking or unticking the boxes in the layer list. This can be expanded by clicking on the arrow to the left of the tick box.

By clicking on the 3 dots at the right-hand side of each layer name, further options are made available as follows:

Zoom to
Transparency
Set visibility range
Disable pop-up
Move up
Move down
View in Attribute Table
Show item details

Zoom to

Zooms the map to the full extent of the selected layer

Transparency

Adjusts the levels of transparency of the selected layer on the map

Disable pop-up

Toggles the display of layer pop-up boxes (on/off)

Move up/down

Move the selected layer shapefiles up or down the display order on the map.

View in attribute table

Lists site attribute table information at bottom of screen



Basemap Gallery

Offers the user a choice of various ordnance survey base maps upon which to view the data.



Attribute table

Opens the attribute table. This shows the information for each layer.



Map Overview

Opens a map overview box, showing full extent of the map on the screen. Enabling fast panning of the map to any given area of the map.



Bookmark

Enables the user to create shortcuts that allow quick navigation to any given area of the map.
